

## Poster Presentations for IDDRG 2009

We apologize for the delay in providing these recommendations. If your poster is already completed, there is no need to make any changes to it. If you are still in the process of creating your poster we have the following recommendations:

1. We suggest that you use font size of 48 points or greater for the Poster Title and Authors and Affiliations.
2. Section titles should have a font size of 36 points or greater.
3. Text on the poster should be of a font size of 28 points or greater. This includes text in tables.
4. Figures should be at least 200 mm (8 in) by 200 mm (8 in) in size. Font size for the labels and legends on graphs should be at least 20 points.
5. It would be best to include more figures and less text. Attendees will have the paper available in the proceedings to see the details, so the poster should concentrate on the major finds and the highlights.
6. It would also be good if you included a photograph of the presenter on the poster so that attendees can find the person to ask questions. We suggest that the photo be 125 mm (5 in) by 175 mm (7 in) and located in the upper right corner of the poster.

The posters will be displayed in the coffee/exhibit area of the Green Center Lobby. We will have easels available with backing boards. The backing boards are of variable sizes up to 2.44 m (8 ft) by 1.22 m (4 ft). Tape and push pins will be available for attaching the poster to the backing board. Staff will be available to help you in getting the poster properly hung and displayed.

It would be good to hang your poster sometime on Monday morning June 1, 2009 and take it down on Wednesday morning June 3, 2009.
